XPO Logistics (Application maintenance)

SVI provided application maintenance and development services to various XPO Logistics applications such as electronic data interchange (EDI), Sales, Pricing, Pickup to Delivery, and Order Management systems.

In addition, SVI provided legacy mainframe analysis support work, analyzed legacy programs and worked with the business analyst and programmers to bridge the gap between the old mainframe legacy systems and the new system.

Aside from analyzing and validating the current Gentran mapping, SVI created the Mapping Requirement Specification (MRS) for the maps that need to be migrated to Sterling Integrator. These maps are customer specific information based on different EDI transactions and the MRS acts as a translator to these two systems.

SVI also participated in migration status planning, performed parallel testing for partners that need to be migrated. Parallel testing is done to check whether the new system provides the same or acceptable outputs as the old system. Parallel testing results were analyzed to determine which partners are ready for migration.

SVI is also involved in the Business Intelligence team of XPO, including functional analytics and support as well as BI report migration.

MyWebGrocer (Data processing and data clean-up)



SVI processed grocery circulars and product information for 30,000,000 products for the North American and Canadian markets with an accuracy requirement of 99.95%. SVI also provided data processing services including product categorizations and product description clean-up for the same volume of grocery products.
